
Sir,

Note : Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors shall also be considered provided they are not short of requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or 2 years, whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation

Officers of the Central/ State Government/ Union Territories. (Central Armed Police Forces, Central/State Police, State Forest Department, Customs, Central Excise, CBI, DRI, Enforcement Directorate, Income Tax and Central Bureau of Narcotics.)

- (a) Holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
- (b) with five years regular service in level-6 in the Pay Matrix of 7th CPC recommendations (Pre-revised: PB-2Rs. 9300-34800 plus grade pay of Rs. 4200/-) in the parent cadre or department.

Essential : Three years experience in enforcement of regulatory laws and collection in Intelligence there to.

Desirable

- (i) One year's experience in investigation of criminal offences or economic offences.

Note 1: The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2: Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organisation or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
