
Sir,

Deputation

Officers of the Central/ State Government/ Union Territories. (Central Armed Police Forces, Central/State Police, State Forest Department Customs, Central Excise, CBI, DRI, Enforcement Directorate, Income Tax, etc.)

(a) (i) Holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or

(ii) with six years regular service in the level-5 of the pay matrix in the parent cadre or department.

(b) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:-

(i) Bachelors Degree in any discipline from a recognized university; and

(ii) **Essential** : Two years experience in enforcement of regulatory laws and collection in Intelligence thereto.

(iii) **Desirable** : One year's experience in investigation of criminal offences or economic offences.

Note : The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation/ absorption. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-

cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications).
