New Delhi, Dated, the _____2018

G.S.R.____(E).— In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Department of Revenue (Narcotics Control Bureau)(Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1994, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called Recruitment of Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Private Secretary (Group 'B' Gazetted, Ministerial posts), Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix. — The number of posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications etc.— The method of recruitment to the said posts , age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Disqualification.—No person,—

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. — Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. — Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

<p>Promotion: Stenographer Grade-I in the level-06 of the pay matrix with five years regular service in the grade.</p> <p>Note 1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors shall also be considered provided they are not short of requisite qualifying/eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying /eligibility service.</p> <p>Deputation: Officers holding the post of Stenographer under the Central Government.</p> <p>(a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or (ii) with five years regular service in the Stenographers grade in the level-06 of the pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department.</p> <p>Note 1: The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall 'Not exceeding 56 years' as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
