From the Desk of Director General

Use of PIT NDPS Act 1988 by Drug Law Enforcement

Illicit trafficking and abuse of illicit drugs pose a serious threat to the health, security and welfare of human beings, and adversely affect the economic, social, cultural and political foundations of the societies.

Drug trafficking involving the cultivation, manufacture, import export, sale of Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances, is an organized crime and a major challenge for Indian law enforcement agencies.

A number of legal instruments are available to law enforcement agencies to combat drug trafficking. These include search, seizure, arrest and prosecution as detailed in NDPS Act. Drug law enforcement agencies use them adequately to combat drug trafficking.

Most drug cases start with seizure of contraband alongwith couriers. Because of secrecy and tight control over information within criminal organizations, often it is very difficult to reach the linchpin. Sometimes even if linchpin is identified, legally admissible adequate evidence may not be there. In such cases preventive detention is often the correct response.

Provision for preventive detention of traffickers is contained in PIT NDPS Act 1988 (Prevention of Illicit Traffic in Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act). In the first National Conference on Drug Law Enforcement, provisions of this Act were discussed and it was resolved that drug law enforcement agencies should use the provision of preventive detention in appropriate cases. I urge all law enforcement agencies and officers to have a look at these provisions and make use of them. NCB would train drug law enforcement officers in different aspects of PIT NDPS Act, if requested.

1. Operations



Banglore Zone

 On 24.04.2018, Officers of NCB, Hyderabad Sub Zone in assistance of NCB Bangalore Zonal Unit seized 957.700 kg of Ganja at Vijayawada. One person was arrested.



 On 01.05.2018, Officers of NCB, Bangalore Zonal Unit seized 1.760 kg of Cocaine at Kempegowda International Airport, Bangalore. One Ugandan national was arrested. The suspected source of the seized drug was Uganda.



On 24.05.2018, Officers of NCB, Bangalore Zonal Unit seized 49 blot papers of LSD (1.05 grams), 13 pills of Ecstasy (5.26 grams), 0.55 gram of MDMA crystals, 85 gram of Hashish, 850 gram of Ganja along with Indian currency of Rs 78,660/- at Vidyaranyapura, Bangalore. Two persons were arrested.

- On 11.06.2018, Officers of NCB Hyderabad Sub zone seized 634.500 kg of Ganja from a lorry at Vijayawada and arrested two persons.
- On 13.06.2018, in a joint operation of NCB Hyderabad Sub Zone and Andhra Police intercepted, three vehicles at NH-16, Rajanagaram, Rajamahendravaram (AP) and seized 1530 Kg Ganja and arrested eight persons including the supplier.



Chandigarh Zone

- On 01.04.2018, Officers of NCB, Amritsar Sub Zone in coordination with BSF, Ram Tirth, Punjab seized 1.970 Kg of Heroin.




