From the Desk of Director General

This issue of *Narcontrol* covers the prime events that took place at Narcotics Control Bureau during the months of January, February and March 2015. The journal is aimed at all the stakeholders in the field of Drug Law Administration in India. Through this publication the Bureau endeavours to apprise its readers of the progress made by the Bureau in the areas of enforcement, coordination, capacity building and creating awareness among the general public against drug abuse.

This issue cover drug seizures, clandestine lab busts and illicit cultivation destructions effected by the Bureau and other Drug Law Enforcement Agencies of India during the first quarter of the year 2015. The special feature highlights some important judgments passed by the courts in favour of the Bureau.

The lead story of the magazine accentuates the 4th Director General level talks between DNC, Bangladesh and NCB, India that were held in Dhaka on 22nd and 23rd March 2015 in a warm and cordial atmosphere. The Bangladesh delegation comprising of 15 members from relevant Ministries and law enforcement agencies was led by Mr. Md. Bazlur Rahman, the Director General of the Department of Narcotics Control (DNC) while the 10 member Indian delegation was led by Mr. B. B. Mishra, the Director General-in-charge of Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB). Besides this, the Bureau also participated in international level coordination meetings like the 58th session of the Commission on Narcotics Drugs at Vienna and a special meeting on precursor control among Cambodia, China, Korea, Myanmar, Thailand held at Bangkok.

As in the past, Narcotics Control Bureau continues to focus on capacity building and training. During the period of January to March 2015, the Bureau organized 136 Drug Law Enforcement training programmes wherein 4835 personnels from different Central/ State agencies were trained. Alongwith enforcement activity, emphasis was also given to demand reduction and 181 awareness programmes were organized in various parts of the country to spread awareness about the ill effects of drug abuse.

I hope the information provided in this issue prove to be useful and interesting for the readers. I look forward to your valuable suggestions to enhance the quality of the journal.

1. Lead Story

4th Director General Level Talks Between DNC, Bangladesh and NCB, India held in Dhaka on 22nd & 23rd March, 2015.

1. The 4th Director General level talks between DNC, Bangladesh and NCB, India were held in Dhaka on 22nd & 23rd March 2015 in a warm and cordial atmosphere. The Bangladesh delegation comprising 15 members from relevant Ministries and law enforcement agencies was led by Mr. Md. Bazlur Rahman, the Director General of the Department of Narcotics Control (DNC), Bangladesh while the 10 member Indian delegation was led by Mr. B. B. Mishra, the Director General-in-charge of Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB), India.

2. Welcoming the Indian delegation, the leader of Bangladesh delegation stated that Bangladesh attaches utmost importance to its relation with India and is thankful for the cooperation extended by the Government of India in various areas especially in illicit trafficking of Narcotic Drugs, Psychotropic Substances and Precursor Chemicals in Bangladesh.

3. In his response, the leader of the Indian delegation thanked his Bangladesh counterpart for the warm hospitality and excellent arrangements made for the Indian delegation in Dhaka. The leader of the Indian delegation reiterated the highest priority that the Government of India attaches to its relations with Bangladesh and reaffirmed India's commitment to eradicate growing trend of drug menace in the region.

4. Both the sides acknowledged the menace of drugs in their border states and its devastating consequences in both the countries.

5. Both the sides agreed to put proper mechanisms in place wherever required to stop the trafficking in narcotic drugs and to check the illicit use of precursor chemicals.

6. It was agreed from both sides that there should be more exchange of intelligence and surveillance on the routes and smuggling points at the border including dossiers of specific drug smugglers. It was also stressed upon that Law enforcement officials of both the sides at the border should have frequent mutual communication and joint visits to these areas.

7. It was also agreed that both sides should take appropriate measures for public awareness, motivation and community mobilization against illicit trafficking of drugs in both the countries.

8. Both the sides further agreed that more efforts should be made for eradication of illicit cultivation of opium poppy and cannabis along the border areas in both the nations.

9. Both the sides underscored the need for an enhanced cooperation in capacity building and mutual sharing of information on best practices for the reduction of demand, supply and harmful effects of drug abuse.

10. Appreciating Indian side for having organized several training programmes/courses, the Bangladesh side requested for more such training programmes/courses for drug law enforcement personnel at various training institutions of India for their capacity building which was readily agreed by Indian side.

11. The talks ended upon the agreement that the 5th Director General level talks between DNC Bangladesh and NCB India would be held in India at a mutually convenient date and time.



2. Operations

Significant Seizures by NCB (Zone wise)

- On 21.02.2015, officers of NCB, Ahmedabad Zonal Unit seized 21.020 kgs of Alprazolam Tablets, 100 Tablets of Modafinil, 2.010 kgs of White Powder, 25 bottles of Cough Syrup, 125 grams of Blue color tablets and 1.785 kgs of White tablets in a follow up operation conducted in connection with the seizure affected on 31.01.2015.

Laboratory Busted

Assam Rifles

The suspected source of the seized drug was Myanmar.

Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI)

- On 08.01.2015, officers of Directorate of Revenue Intelligence, Gorakhpur intercepted a vehicle at Gorakhpur Sonouli Road and seized 185 kgs of Hashish. The drug was concealed inside a specially built cavity.

- During the month of February, 2015, officers of the Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) seized 20.950 kgs of Hashish, 961.500 kgs of Ganja, 935 grams of Heroin, 1.500 kgs of Opium and 31200 bottles of Phensedyl Cough Syrup in 17 cases and arrested 21 persons including 03 Nepal nationals & 01 Spain national. The suspected source of the seized drugs in most of these cases was Nepal.
- During the month of March, 2015, officers of the Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) seized 2.100 kgs of Hashish, 207 kgs of Ganja, 159 grams of Heroin & 10 grams of Opium in 06 cases and arrested 06 persons including 03 Nepal nationals. The suspected source of the seized drugs in most of these cases was Nepal.




TITLE: NCB VS. Soni Khatun and others







4. Capacity Building

Assistance to states & Union Territories

A Scheme to finance State Governments to strengthen their enforcement capabilities for combating illicit trafficking in Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances was launched by the Union Ministry of Home Affairs on October 24th, 2004 at an estimated cost of Rs.10.00 Crore. The Scheme was valid for period of 5 years i.e till 31.3.2009. Considering the need for continuation of the Central Assistance Scheme and its objectives, the Government of India has further decided to extend this Scheme for a further period of 5 years i.e from 2009-10 to 2013 with an estimated budget of Rs.15 crore. The government of India has further decided to extend this Scheme for a further period of 3 years i.e from 2014-15 to 2016-17 with an estimated budget of Rs.15 Crore on 04.12.2014.

On extension of the Scheme on 4.12.2014, the proposal from different States and UTs were invited. After processing the proposal, the meeting of Empowered Committee was held on 10.03.2015 wherein the following six states were sanctioned fund as per details given below:-

- Ketamine Detection Kits - 215



Computer Based Training module.

NCB is organizing CBTs in capacity building for combating illicit trafficking of narcotics drugs and psychotropic substances at CBT established centres at NCB Headquarters and three metro Zones viz. Kolkata, Mumbai and Chennai since 2012. The software module is based on International best practices as part of a project of UNODC to strengthen the Drug Law Enforcement capacities in South Asia. It is a self-evaluation programme utilized for enhancing the skills and knowledge of personnel on specific modules of drug law enforcement. With the approval of the MHA, CBT Centers have also been opened in other zones namely Lucknow, Jodhpur, Ahmedabad, Chandigarh, Jammu, Indore, Guwahati, Patna and Bangalore. The bar diagram below shows the number of personnel who attended the CBT training from different organizations.

CBT has the following features:

The modules cover all aspects of drug law enforcement including intelligence, investigation, precursor trafficking and anti money laundering. It is possible to design a variety of courses ranging from few hours to few days, weeks or months. The course content can thus be made specific to the target groups. The interactive nature of the modules facilitates enhancement in retention capacity of the Learners. This module has pre and post test facilities which enable the administrator to assess the impact of learning process.

3. Proposal for upgradation of Goa and Imphal Sub Zones to full fledged Zones and creation of new Sub Zones at Silchar (Assam) and Siliguri (WB)

A consolidated proposal dated 01.08.2014 has been submitted to the MHA for upgradation of Goa and Imphal Sub Zones to full fledged Zones (having jurisdiction over the State of Goa in case of Goa Zone and over the States of Manipur & Nagaland in case of Imphal Zone) and creation of new Sub Zones at Silchar (Assam) and Siliguri (WB) in order to enhance operational efficiency and effective coordination in the field of drug interdiction. A reply of MHA query dated 08.09.2014 was submitted to the MHA vide NCB letter dated 15.10.2014. As per directions of MHA dated 11.12.2014, check list for creation of all the posts were submitted to MHA vide NCB letter dated 04.01.2015.

4. Review of Cadre Structure of NCB

Review of cadre structure is in process at NCB on the recommendation of Task Force on National Security (TFNS) keeping in view the rapidly changing scenario and new challenges in the field of international trafficking patterns. NCB, Hqrs. vide letter dated 18.12.2014 has requested all DDGs, Zonal Directors and Superintendents to send their views/comments. Matter is under further process and a draft proposal is being prepared.

5. Notification of Recruitment Rules

Revised Recruitment Rules for Section Officers and Staff Car Drivers (Spl. Gd., Gd. I, Gd. II and Ordinary Grade) have been finalized by MHA, DOPT, UPSC and Ministry of Law. The same are at the final stage of notification at MHA.



6. Conversion of temporary posts into permanent posts in NCB

A proposal dated 04.03.2015 has been sent to the MHA for conversion of 906 temporary posts into permanent posts.

- स्वापक नियंत्रण ब्यूरो मुख्यालय की वर्ष 2014-15 की राजभाषा कार्यान्वयन समिति की तीसरी बैठक 17.12.2014 को आयोजित की गई थी। बैठक में लिए गए निर्णयानुसार 40 प्रतिशत अनुभागों को कुछ कार्य केवल हिन्दी में करने के अनुक्रम में प्रशासन तथा लेखा अनुभाग को कुछ निर्दिष्ट कार्य केवल हिन्दी में करने हेतु विनिर्दिष्ट करने की प्रक्रिया जारी है।
