Alongwith enforcement activity, special emphasis was also given on demand reduction aspect and 234 awareness programmes were organized in various parts of the country to spread awareness about the ill effects of drug abuse. A facebook page was also launched to educate the people specially youth about drug abuse.

I hope the information provided in this issue would be both worth and interesting. I look forward to your valuable suggestions to enhance the quality of the journal.

1. Lead Story Mann ki Baat



The Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 14-12-2014, in his third 'Mann Ki Baat' programme on radio, expressed that society as well as the government will have to work together to fight the problem of "devastating" drug addiction menace and that a helpline would be set up soon for its solutions.

The Prime Minister also suggested launching a special drive on social media against the menace.

He said that the menace is a "national pain" but instead of the youth mired in the problem, drugs should be shunned. According to him drug addiction is "a malaise filled 3D — darkness, destruction and devastation — as it leads to the dark alleys of destruction and devastation".

The Prime Minister said he will try to involve celebrities from the cine world, sports and other fields to campaign for a "drug-free India".

He said that some son has got caught in such a quagmire where everything is devastated. Drugs are such devastation. At the same time, he said, "drug addiction is bad, not the child."

The Prime Minister said the family, friends, society, government and the law will have to work together to fight it as working in pieces will not help, this being a psycho-socio-medical problem.





Important Court Judgement

Title: NCB vs. Sanjeev kumar @ sanjay

On 07.04.2013, Narcotics Control Bureau, Chandigarh Zonal Unit arrested one person namely Sanjeev Kumar @ Sanjay along with 03.300 Kgs of Charas. The complaint in the case was filed in Chandigarh Court on 06.09.2013. The Additional Session Judge, Chandigarh convicted accused Sanjeev Kumar and awarded Rigorous Imprisonment for 10 years and a fine of Rs.01 Lakh (two and half years in default) on 18.11.2014.

Title: NCB vs. Tarun Kumar Dey

NDPS Case No. 52/07, NCB Crime No. 08/07: On 06.05.2007, Narcotics Control Bureau, Kolkata arrested 02 persons namely Tarun Kumar Dey and Raju Sarkar along with 345Kgs of Ganja. The complaint in the case was filed in Spl. NDPS Court Berhampur, Murshidabad on 21.09.2007. The Additional Session Judge, Berhampur convicted on 23.12.2014 both the accused and awarded Rigorous Imprisonment for 10 years and a fine of Rs.01 Lakh.

Title: NCB Vs. Gurmeet Singh and Pyarelal Shridhar keer

On 08.05.2010, NCB Mumbai seized 40 Kgs of Hashish and Rs.5 lakhs with two persons namely Gurmeet Singh and Pyarelal Shridhar keer. The Complaint was filed on 22.10.2010 in Mumbai Sessions Court. In Judgment both accused have been awarded rigorous imprisonment for 15 years each and Rs.1 Lakh as fine to each.







4. Capacity Building

Assistance to states & Union Territories

A Scheme to finance State Governments to strengthen their enforcement capabilities for combating illicit Traffic in Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances was launched by the Union Ministry of Home Affairs on October 24th, 2004 at an estimated cost of Rs.10.00 Crore. The Scheme was valid for period of 5 years i.e till 31.3.2009. Considering the need for continuation of the Central Assistance Scheme and its objectives, the Government fo India has further decided to extend this Scheme for a further period of 5 years i.e from 2009-10 to 2013 with an estimated budget of Rs.15 crore. The government of India has further decided to extend this Scheme for a further period of 3 years i.e from 2014-15 to 2016-17 with an estimated budget of Rs.15 Crore on 04.12.2014.

On extension of the Scheme on 4.12.2014, the proposal from different States and UTs has been invited. The Proposal from different States & UTs is being received and processed.

Drugs Detection Kits

Narcotics Control Bureau placed the supply order on 26th November, 2014 to Hindustan Antibiotics Limited (HAL), Pune for procuring the following numbers of Drug Detection Kits: -

- a) Standard size Narcotics Drug Detection Kits 1006
- b) Precursors Chemical Detection kits 379
- c) Ketamine Detection Kits 215

The above numbers of Drug Detection Kits will be dispatched to NCB Zones and Sub-Zone for further distribution to drug law enforcement agencies in their jurisdictions.

Training

NCB has been regularly organizing training programs to enhance and sharpen the specialized skills required to improve performance and effectiveness of the personnel involved in drug law enforcement. During October to December, 2014, NCB organized 137 training courses and a total of 3109 personnel working in various Central / State agencies were trained.



Computer Based Training module

NCB is organizing CBTs in capacity building for combating illicit trafficking of narcotics drugs and psychotropic substances at CBT established centers at NCB Headquarters and three metro Zones i.e. Kolkata, Mumbai and Chennai since 2012. The software module is based on International best practices as part of a project of UNODC to strengthen the Drug Law Enforcement capacities in South Asia. It is a self-evaluation programme utilized for enhancing the skills and knowledge of personnel on specific modules of drug law enforcement. With the approval of the MHA, CBT Centers have already opened in other zones namely Lucknow, Jodhpur, Ahmedabad, Chandigarh, Jammu, Indore, Guwahati, Patna and Bangalore. The bar diagram below shows the number of personnel attended the CBT training from different organizations.

CBT has the following features

The modules cover all aspects of drug law enforcement including intelligence, investigation, precursor trafficking and anti money laundering. It is possible to design a variety of courses ranging from few hours to few days, weeks or months. The course content can thus be made specific to the target groups. The interactive nature of the modules facilitates enhancement in retention capacity of the Learners. This module has pre and post test facilities which enables the administrator to assess the impact of learning process.

Drug demand reduction

One of the core duties of Narcotics Control Bureau is to create public awareness regarding the ill-effects of drug abuse which is corroding the modern society and to promote the concept of living healthy life free of drugs. This is done through various platforms including awareness campaigns, rallies, print and visual media etc.

4. Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2014 (LDCE) for the post of Intelligence Officer
