More than 26,500 people have been arrested and drugs worth ₹3,253 crore seized across [Assam](#) since 2021, Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said on Sunday (August 30, 2026).

He said huge quantities of narcotic substances originate in Myanmar, and enter Assam through various routes in Mizoram and Manipur for further distribution in the rest of India.

“Since 2021, with a single-minded focus on our mission #AssamAgainstDrugs, our police and allied agencies have waged a relentless, daily battle against the narcotics trade. The numbers tell their own story — narcotics worth more than ₹3,253 crore seized, and over 26,500 offenders arrested since the campaign began,” Mr. Sarma said in a social media post.

He said the number of arrests has climbed steadily each year from 4,175 in 2021 to 4,901 in 2025, asserting this was not a one-time drive but a “sustained and institutionalised war” on drugs.

In 2021, Mr. Sarma became the Chief Minister for the first time after the BJP came to power in Assam for the second consecutive term.

Talking about the origin and route of the drug movement, the CM said, “Assam sits on a difficult geography — a transit corridor for narcotics originating in Myanmar and routed through Mizoram and Manipur before moving deeper into the country.” Kingpins often operate beyond our borders, which is precisely why this cannot be Assam’s fight alone, he said.

“This is where the Prime Minister’s leadership and the Centre’s unwavering support have made a real difference — intensified coordination with Myanmar, strengthened surveillance along inter-State borders, sharper intelligence sharing and deployment of technology that helps our forces intercept consignments before they spread further,” Mr. Sarma said.

He further said that the Assam Police have not worked in isolation, but have worked as an extension of a national resolve to eliminate the menace of drugs.

**The BGB claimed that the Indian resident was caught at the Kumarshail border area in Barlekha upazila of Moulvibazar on August 27. They found a foreign-made pistol, two rounds of .22-bore ammunition and 500 Yaba tablets from him.**

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A 35-year-old man from the Sribhumi district of Assam, who has been missing since Thursday (August 27), has been found in Bangladesh by the Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB). The person has been identified as Balai Namasudra, a resident of Gobindapur village in Sribhumi district. After the discovery, BGB claimed that Namasudra was smuggling drugs and arms into Bangladesh.

Balai's wife, Mamata Namasudra, stated that he would regularly go fishing near the border pillar every day, and on Thursday morning, at around 5:30 am, he had gone to collect the fish in the net he had set up the previous evening. She further stated that later that day, an individual from Bangladesh called her on WhatsApp and requested photocopies of Balai's voter ID, Aadhaar card and passport, if possible.

"The person told me that Balai has been caught in Bangladesh for entering there illegally and he will be sent back after basic documentation, for which these documents were important, and I shared them through WhatsApp," she said.



# 80,000 Yaba tablets worth Rs 16 crore seized in Cachar, one arrested

[Cachar](#) ([Assam](#)) [India], August 31 (ANI): [Assam](#) Police seized 80,000 [Yaba tablets](#) valued at Rs 16 crore in [Cachar](#) district and apprehended one person, officials said on Sunday. Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) of [Cachar](#) district, Partha Protim Das, stated that the recovery was made as part of a major anti-narcotics operation. Based on specific intelligence inputs, police intercepted a vehicle with registration number AS-01-GC-7852 at Dolu, Moinagarh, under the jurisdiction of the Borkhola police station. During the inspection, police recovered 80,000 [Yaba tablets](#) concealed in a secret chamber of the vehicle.

Later, the police apprehended 25-year-old accused Somsul Hussain Laskar. "During a thorough search, 80,000 [Yaba tablets](#) concealed in a secret chamber of the vehicle were recovered. One person, namely Somsul Hussain Laskar (25 years old) S/O Harish Ali R/O Jamalpur PS Dholai was apprehended. The vehicle was coming from a neighbouring state," SSP Das said. [Assam](#) Chief Minister [Himanta Biswa Sarma](#) lauded the successful operation by [Cachar](#) Police by making a reference of Jack and Jill nursery rhyme. In a post on X, CM Sarma wrote: "Jack and Jill went up the hill, Thinking they'd make a quick ₹16 cr deal. But @cacharpolice had other plans...80,000 [Yaba tablets](#) seized from a secret chamber in a vehicle. One accused apprehended, huge haul off the streets." Police confirmed that further investigation is underway to ascertain the forward and backward linkages of the narcotics network. Earlier, the Special Task Force (STF) of [Assam](#) Police recovered and seized 397 grams of suspected heroin and apprehended three drug traffickers in Guwahati, officials said. Acting on specific information regarding the transportation of narcotic drugs, the STF, [Assam](#), launched an operation during the night of August 27-28, 2026, and intercepted a car at Sonkochi Path, Beharbari, under Basistha Police Station in Guwahati. "During the search of the vehicle, 37 soap cases containing suspected heroin, weighing 397 grams (net weight), were recovered from two bags. Three persons travelling in the vehicle were also apprehended, and they were identified as Kiron Singha (49) of [Assam](#)'s [Cachar](#) district, S Nengpi Vaiphei (36) of Imphal East, Manipur and Ngaineichong (41) of Churachandpur, Manipur," Pranab Kumar Pegu, SSP of STF, [Assam](#), said. In addition to the suspected heroin, Rs 21,000 in cash, mobile handsets, SIM cards, two bags and the vehicle were seized during the operation. In this connection, STF PS Case No. 08/2026 has been registered.

# Assam Rifles seizes heroin worth Rs 1.87 crore from near Myanmar border

Assam Rifles seized heroin worth over Rs 1.87 crore from Champhai district near the India-Myanmar border, an official said on Sunday.

Acting on specific intelligence about the movement of narcotics, Assam Rifles personnel laid an ambush along the Tiau river in the Vangkai area of Zokhawthar in Champhai district on Saturday, the Assam Rifles spokesperson said.

During the operation, the troops spotted a woman crossing the river carrying a green polybag. After placing the bag on the riverbank, she signalled to a person waiting on a scooter.

On noticing the Assam Rifles personnel approaching, the woman fled towards Myanmar while the other person escaped on the scooter, leaving the bag behind, the official said.

A subsequent search of the bag led to the recovery of 250.21 grams of heroin estimated to be worth over Rs 1.87 crore, she said.

The seized contraband was handed over to the Excise and Narcotics Department in Champhai for further investigation and legal proceedings, she added.

# Woman among 7 militants arrested in Manipur; arms, drugs seized

**Imphal:** Security forces in Manipur, in separate joint operations conducted across different districts, have arrested seven militants, including a woman cadre, belonging to various banned outfits during the past 24 hours, officials said here on Sunday.

In another joint operation, security forces also recovered a cache of arms and ammunition and arrested two drug peddlers, seizing narcotic substances from their possession in Manipur's Bishnupur district.

A police official said that the seven militants were apprehended in Imphal West, Imphal East, Thoubal and Kakching districts during coordinated operations conducted by the Manipur Police, Assam Rifles and other Central security forces.

The arrested militants belong to the banned Kangleipak Communist Party (KCP), United National Liberation Front (UNLF), People's Liberation Army (PLA) and its political wing, the Revolutionary People's Front (RPF), and Kanglei Yawol Kanna Lup (KYKL).

The official said the arrested militants were reportedly involved in numerous crimes and illegal activities, including attacks on people, kidnapping, forcible collection of "subscriptions" and recruitment of youths into the banned outfits.

Of the seven militants, a combined team of security forces, including the Manipur Police, arrested an active woman cadre of the KCP (People's War Group) from Thoubal district. She was identified as Laishram Abem Devi (37).

A combined team of the police and other security forces also recovered a substantial cache of arms and ammunition from Bishnupur district. The recovered arms and ammunition included one 9 mm pistol with a magazine, one .32 pistol with a magazine, one country-made AK rifle with a magazine, one country-made MP-9 with a magazine, one country-made SBBL gun, one country-made .22 rifle with a magazine, two 36-hand grenades, two improvised explosive devices (IEDs), a large quantity of ammunition of various calibres and other accessories.

Meanwhile, the Manipur Police, during a routine frisking and checking duty in the Sericulture Training Centre area, arrested two drug peddlers and seized five soap cases containing heroin weighing around 53 grams from their possession.

The arrested drug peddlers were identified as Amir Khan (34) and Md. Bungo (33). A two-wheeler used by the accused was also seized, the official said.

Meanwhile, security forces comprising the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) and the Manipur Police have continued extensive counter-insurgency operations, including search operations and area-domination exercises, in fringe, mixed-population and other vulnerable areas across the state.

As part of the intensified security measures, 111 nakas and checkpoints have been set up across the valley and hill districts to monitor the movement of militants, anti-social elements and suspicious vehicles.

The security forces have also been providing armed escorts to trucks and other vehicles carrying essential commodities along the strategically important Imphal-Jiribam National Highway (NH-37).

Strict security arrangements and convoy protection continue to remain in place along vulnerable stretches of the highway to ensure the safe and uninterrupted movement of passenger and goods vehicles, the officials said.

**Basistha Police arrested two alleged drug peddlers in Guwahati after a tip-off. Officers seized heroin and Nitro-10 tablets, and began legal proceedings and investigation.**

Acting on specific intelligence, an EGPD team from Basistha Police Station busted a major drug haul in Guwahati and arrested two alleged drug peddlers, identified as Pradip Paul (44) and Janki Devi (25), both residents of Natun Bazaar.

Police seized 88 grams of heroin packed in seven soap boxes along with 2,490 Nitro-10 tablets weighing approximately 1.9 kg during the operation.

The arrested duo and the seized substances have been taken into custody for further legal proceedings and investigation.

# 52 Kg Dry Ganja Seized from Private Car in Joint BSF-Police Operation in Belonia

Agartala, 30<sup>th</sup> August 2026 : A joint operation by the Border Security Force (BSF) and Tripura Police led to the seizure of around 52 kg of dry ganja from a private car at Daspara in Naluya Abhayanagar under Hrishyamukh Block of Belonia subdivision in South Tripura on Sunday.

According to reports, the security personnel intercepted a private vehicle bearing registration number \*TR01-AAR-0608\* after chasing it in the area. During the operation, the driver reportedly abandoned the vehicle and fled from the spot.

The security personnel subsequently searched the vehicle and recovered a large quantity of dry ganja. The seizure has raised concerns in the border area, particularly amid ongoing efforts by security agencies to curb drug trafficking.

Soon after receiving information about the incident, the Sub-Divisional Police Officer (SDPO) of Sabroom reached the spot. A forensic team also arrived later and collected necessary samples as part of the investigation.

The seizure has created tension in the locality. Residents questioned how such a large consignment of narcotics could be transported despite regular naka checking and surveillance in border areas.

Local residents expressed concern over the growing impact of drug trafficking on the younger generation and urged the authorities to intensify action against ganja and other narcotics. They also demanded that those involved in the trafficking network be identified and brought to justice.

Police have launched an investigation to trace the absconding driver and identify other persons allegedly involved in the transportation of the seized contraband.

# Basistha Police Launch Anti-Drug Operation, Arrest Man-Woman Duo

During the operation, police seized seven packets of suspected drugs, around 8 kg of marijuana (ganja), and banned tablets. Further investigation is underway.

# Drug awareness campaign held in Wokha

A drug trafficking and substance abuse awareness campaign was held in Wokha on August 28, sensitising students and the public on drug abuse, trafficking, tobacco use and addiction prevention.

**DIMAPUR —** A drug trafficking and substance abuse awareness campaign was held at the conference hall of Police Baptist Church, Wokha, on August 28 to sensitise students and the public to the dangers of drug abuse, trafficking and tobacco consumption.

The programme was organised by the District Executive Force (DEF) Wokha/Anti-Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) in collaboration with the Wokha District Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan, District AIDS Prevention and Control Unit and District Tobacco Control Unit, a DIPR report stated.

A total of 80 participants, including 65 students and 15 others, attended the programme. Students from Santsuo School, Wokha, and Unit Regimental School, DEF Wokha, participated in the campaign.

Addressing the gathering, Additional SP Wokha and Nodal Officer, ANTF Wokha, Biren Lotha, spoke on drug trafficking, substance abuse, major drug hotspots and inter-State drug movement.

He urged students and the community to remain vigilant and proactive in preventing the spread of drug-related activities.

District Welfare Officer, Wokha, C James Ezung, spoke on different types of drugs, their effects, and the meaning of drug abuse and intoxication.

He encouraged students to confide in trusted elders and seek help when facing difficulties, stressing the approach of “Refuse, Resist and Report” in combating drug abuse.

Tshopeu Khutsoh, psychologist under the National Tobacco Control Programme (NTCP), District Hospital Wokha, sensitised participants on the harmful effects of tobacco use.

She explained the two broad forms of tobacco consumption—smoking and smokeless tobacco—and highlighted the serious health consequences associated with tobacco use, including oral cancer.

Khutsoh also reminded participants of the legal restrictions on the sale of tobacco products to minors and near educational institutions. Students were informed about the availability of free treatment for tobacco dependence at Dr. Motsuo Memorial Hospital, Wokha, and encouraged those struggling with addiction to seek professional help.



An interactive session was held during which students raised questions and engaged with the resource persons.

Biren Lotha also highlighted the importance of cleanliness, personal hygiene and healthy lifestyle habits, urging students to cultivate discipline and good practices.

As part of the initiative, on-the-spot medical testing for HIV, syphilis and hepatitis was also conducted.

# Flyer on Phuket-B'luru flight tries to hide drugs in loo overhead panel

**New Delhi:** A passenger flying from Phuket to Bangalore Friday allegedly tried to conceal narcotics in the overhead oxygen mask panel of Air India Express flight (IX 903). Sources said he was allegedly carrying 13 packets of contraband substance he had bought in Phuket.

“He tried to hide them in an overhead panel of the aircraft lavatory. When he was not able to either do so or conceal the entire stuff with him, he threw some in the bin,” said sources. They add this passenger told the crew he had inadvertently damaged an overhead panel while changing clothes in the lav.

When the aircraft landed in Bangalore around 7pm Friday, there were customs officials at the aerobridge who are learnt to have arrested him.

An AI Express spokesperson said: “We are aware of an ongoing investigation involving smuggling of a prohibited substance by a passenger on a flight from Phuket. We maintain strict protocols and continue to support the authorities in all investigations.”

Thiruvananthapuram, Aug 30 (PTI) Home Minister Ramesh Chennithala on Sunday said the recent seizure of over 12 kg of MDMA in Malappuram was the largest-ever in Keralam and that the roots of a drug mafia network were being targeted as part of the anti-narcotic drive 'Operation Toofan'.

In a post on 'X', Chennithala said a 97-gram MDMA seizure in Malappuram led investigators to the larger consignment and that the operation was targeting a major network allegedly smuggling synthetic drugs into Keralam.

"Operation Toofan is currently targeting the root of a major mafia network smuggling synthetic drugs into Kerala," he said.

Chennithala said more than 10,000 arrests have been made so far under Operation Toofan, which he said demonstrated the extent to which law enforcement had penetrated the network.

"The storm of Operation Toofan will sweep away this death-peddling mafia. That is the promise the Kerala Government and I give to this land. We will uproot drugs completely," he said.

Malappuram police on Friday arrested three persons in Coimbatore in neighbouring Tamil Nadu and seized over 12 kg of MDMA worth around Rs 10 crore.

The arrest and seizure were made as part of the investigation into a commercial quantity drug seizure case registered at Manjeri police station on August 6, in which nearly 97 grams of MDMA was recovered.

When his baggage was checked, 6 transparent airtight packets containing hydroponic ganja weighing 2,960 grams valued at Rs. 3 crore were found. The contraband was seized and the passenger was arrested.

**Hyderabad:** The Jeedimetla police on Sunday, August 30, arrested two persons, including a woman, for allegedly possessing ganja worth Rs 11.38 lakh in Hyderabad's Qutbullapur.

Ahmedabad: A suspected narcotics 'dead drop' was uncovered in Vatva on Saturday evening after an autorickshaw driver found a concealed packet containing a white powder while cleaning his vehicle and alerted the Ahmedabad Crime Branch. According to a complaint filed with the Detection of Crime Branch police, Akash Chunara, 28, was cleaning his autorickshaw near Navapura Crossroads on Shantidham Jain Tirth Road around 3.30pm when he noticed a cloth-wrapped packet hidden between the yellow hood and a wooden panel behind the right side of the rear seat. Suspicious about its contents, Chunara examined the packet and found a white powder inside. Believing it could be a narcotic substance, he informed a crime branch constable through a WhatsApp call. He told investigators that he did not know who had placed the packet in the vehicle or when it had been left there. A crime branch team, accompanied by panch witnesses and a photographer, reached the spot and inspected the autorickshaw. Police said no other contraband was found during the search of the vehicle or the driver. A preliminary test conducted by an FSL scientific officer using a narcotics detection kit indicated that the substance was mephedrone.

The seized drug weighed 18.6 grams. Police estimated the value of the mephedrone at Rs 55,980 and collected samples for detailed forensic analysis. Investigators suspect the packet may have been planted as a 'dead drop', a method used to conceal contraband at a designated location for pickup by another person at a later stage. A case under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act has been registered against an unidentified person.

# Drones, Darknet Networks and Poultry-Farm Drug Labs

A 547-gram handover at Mumbai's Mira Road led investigators from two foreign carriers to an Indore supply route. Across India, the 2026 seizure trail runs through Pakistani drones, Manipur highways, Gulf airports, coastal containers, courier parcels and synthetic-drug factories hidden inside poultry farms. India is now a market, manufacturing base and global trafficking junction. But do bigger hauls prove that enforcement is winning, or that far more drugs are getting through?

The bus from Indore rolled into Mira Road carrying two passengers, two packets and a much larger map.

Officers from the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence's Mumbai unit had reportedly been watching for an inter-state narcotics delivery. They intercepted a Kenyan woman arriving from Madhya Pradesh and a Nigerian national who had come to receive the consignment.

Inside the woman's luggage, officers found two packets marked "LV". A field-testing kit indicated that the 547 grams of white crystalline material contained cocaine and methaqualone, according to the DRI. Both passengers were arrested under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act. Laboratory confirmation and the search for other members of the alleged network remain part of the investigation.

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Measured against India's biggest seizures of 2026, 547 grams barely registers.

In January, DRI seized 270 kg of mephedrone from a truck in Rajasthan. In May, the Narcotics Control Bureau said it recovered 349 kg of cocaine from warehouses in the Mumbai region. The same month, NCB announced India's first Captagon seizure, involving more than 227 kg of tablets and powder recovered from Delhi and Gujarat.

The Mira Road bust matters for another reason. A bus had connected Indore to Mumbai. An international carrier allegedly delivered the luggage. Another foreign national waited downstream. Cocaine, a South American drug that commands premium prices in Indian cities, travelled alongside methaqualone, a sedative once sold legally under brands such as Quaalude and Mandrax.

# Delhi police arrests 193, registers 154 FIRs in 72 hour Op crackdown

New Delhi [India], August 30 (ANI): Delhi Police arrested 193 people in a 72-hour operation crackdown against organised crime, drugs in the city, North District, Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP) Niharika Bhatt said on Sunday.

Speaking about the operation, DCP Bhatt said that Delhi police conducted 'Operation Chakra 72' from the night of August 24 to August 27.

'A total of 154 FIRs were registered, and 193 people were arrested in different cases,' DCP Bhatt informed.

'Our focus was on organised crime, drugs, excise and gambling... In excise cases, around 10,000 quarters of liquor were recovered, and 63 people were arrested. We also identified drug hotspots and conducted a focused campaign, recovering ganja, heroin, charas, buprenorphine and fentanyl injections. We also recovered 544 grams of charas and tablets from one person, who said he had brought them from Himachal Pradesh. Now that the operation is over, we are working to trace the links.'

In a separate development, Delhi Police said that they have seized 223 kg of illegal firecrackers meant for illegal sale ahead of Diwali. The accused was arrested after he could not produce any licence.

On 26 August 2026, officers on routine patrol in Samta Vihar, Mukundpur, noticed a man sitting suspiciously in a vehicle, police said.

'The vehicle was loaded with plastic sacks. When police checked the sacks, they found Diwali-style bombs and other firecrackers,' police said. (ANI)



# Nigerian woman arrested in Indore with cocaine worth Rs 29 lakh

Indore: A Nigerian woman who had come to India on a seven-month business visa was arrested in Indore with 57.18 grams of cocaine worth more than Rs 29 lakh.

Additional DCP Dishesh Agarwal said that the woman, identified as Imyunel Joy, a resident of Lagos, who was staying in Mumbai's Bandra East, was caught during police surveillance in the Sinhasa IT Park area on Saturday. A mobile phone was also seized from her.

Police said that a team deployed for surveillance in crowded areas during [Raksha Bandhan](#) spotted Joy carrying a black bag in the IT Park area. She was stopped and questioned about her presence there, but failed to give satisfactory answers and appeared nervous while speaking in English. Suspicious of her movements, the team searched her bag and found a transparent plastic pouch containing cocaine.

A case was subsequently registered against her under Sections 8 and 21 of the NDPS Act at Chandan Nagar police station.

During questioning, Joy told police that she had purchased cocaine at a lower price and intended to sell it in Indore at a higher price to make quick financial gains. Police have taken her on remand and are questioning her about the source of cocaine, the supplier, people involved in its purchase and sale, and others who may be part of the network.

Since Joy is a foreign national, police are also verifying her passport, business visa, immigration status, entry and exit records and details of her stay in India through the concerned agencies. Investigators are examining her mobile communications and other digital evidence to establish backward and forward links in the suspected drug network.

Police are also looking into the Mumbai-Indore connection, including the source from which the cocaine was procured, her local contacts, potential buyers and other associates.

Police on Sunday arrested three persons in two separate anti-drug operations, recovering a total of 2.446 kg of heroin, ₹5,000 in alleged drug money, two firearms —a .30-bore Beretta pistol with a magazine and four cartridges, and a .32-bore revolver with six cartridges — and a motorcycle, officials said.

Sharing details, senior superintendent of police Aditya said in the first operation, a joint police party from the special branch, Gurdaspur, and Behrampur police station was conducting patrolling in the border area when they spotted two youths. On seeing the police, one of them fled towards the fields and escaped, while the other, identified as Nishan Singh alias Sonu, 20, of Mallok Chak, falling under Dorangla police station, was apprehended, the SSP said. His search led to the recovery of four packets containing 2.184kg of heroin, a .30-bore Beretta pistol with magazine and four cartridges.

“Preliminary interrogation revealed that the consignment had allegedly been smuggled from Pakistan through a drone. An FIR was registered at Behrampur police station under relevant sections of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act and the Arms Act. Police said Nishan has no previous criminal history, while efforts are underway to arrest his associate who escaped.

In the second operation, a police party from Dhariwal police station intercepted two youths riding a motorcycle during patrolling. Their search led to the recovery of 262 grams of heroin, ₹5,000 in alleged drug money and a .32-bore revolver with six cartridges.

The arrested accused were identified as Dalbir Singh, 45, of Kalyanpur, and Nitish Kumar, 30, of Dhariwal.

An FIR was registered at Dhariwal police station under the NDPS and Arms Acts. Police said all three accused would be questioned to establish their backward and forward linkages. Further investigation is underway.

## 28 kg opium from Manipur seized at Punjab

The Fazilka police claimed to have recovered 28 kg of opium, allegedly smuggled from Manipur, from two drug peddlers on Sunday.

Fazilka is a border city in Punjab.

According to sources, it is perhaps the first case involving the recovery of such a huge consignment allegedly smuggled from a northeastern state to the border district of Fazilka.

Superintendent of Police (Investigation) Satinder Kumar said a police party had laid a naka for routine checking when it intercepted a canter (PB-13-BS-6581) near the Hanumangarh overbridge on the outskirts of Abohar town. The police recovered the contraband, packed in plastic bags, from the vehicle.

The police also arrested the two occupants of the canter, identified as Sajan alias Majnu, a resident of Chanan Khera village, and Gurmit Singh, a resident of Baba Deep Singh locality in Abohar town.

The accused have been booked under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act. SP Satinder Kumar told The Tribune that the accused had reportedly confessed to having smuggled the contraband from Manipur.

He said the police were yet to ascertain why the consignment had been procured from such a distant State and to whom it was to be handed over in the border district.

The SP said Sajan Kumar was already facing three criminal cases under the NDPS Act in Fazilka and Muktsar districts.

# Woman nabbed with 50 grams of brown sugar near India-Nepal border

Kolkata, Aug 30 (IANS) Troops of the Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) apprehended a 48-year-old woman close to the India-Nepal border in Bihar's Gaya district and seized 50 grams of suspected brown sugar from her on Sunday.

"Upon receipt of specific information from the Galgaliya Police Station in Bihar around 10 a.m., a joint operation was conducted by personnel of G Company, Bhatgaon, A Company, Nemuguri of the 41Bn SSB and the local police at the residence of Sabana Khatun at Timber Depot, close to the Galgalia railway station (Gaya)," a senior SSB official said.

"During the raid, 50 grams of suspected brown sugar was recovered from her house that is located about 450 metres from border pillar number 102," he said.

During interrogation, the woman disclosed that her husband, Md Mustaq, and son, Sohrab, are presently in jail in connection with cases related to drug trafficking. The woman has been taken into custody by the Galgaliya Police Station. It is being ascertained whether she is also involved in the drug trade.

"Her mobile phone will be checked. We will also speak to locals to know more about her activities. It is possible that she is part of a larger network involved in the trafficking of drugs in the area," a police official said.

Drug trafficking is rampant in the area close to the India-Nepal border. Criminals take advantage of the boundary between Bihar and West Bengal and the international border to carry out their nefarious activities, authorities said.

"Once they cross over into West Bengal, the Bihar Police have no jurisdiction and vice versa. The police have no jurisdiction close to the border, while the SSB can't operate too far inside. The criminals are aware of this and take advantage," another official said.

The unique nature of the border between India and Nepal also poses a problem for the enforcers. Citizens of both countries require no passports or visas to move across, and not everybody can be searched without a valid reason. Cross-border trafficking of drugs also takes place.

In the past, Indians have been apprehended in Nepal with drugs, while citizens of that country have been found in possession of drugs in India. The heavy tourist footfall in Nepal and the demand for banned substances is also an issue.

Officials suspect that several gangs operate in the area. Over time, better co-ordination has evolved between the various agencies, and there is regular information sharing. Intelligence networks have also been activated for information about criminals.

"Apart from maintaining vigil along the border, we co-ordinate with central and state agencies to prevent crime in the area. Locals are also regularly told to seek out help to keep the area crime-free for their own sake," the SSB official added.

Hazaribag: A suspected opium trafficker was shot in the abdomen and arrested after he allegedly opened fire on police during a raid in Hazaribag's Chouparan on Saturday evening. Two of his associates were also arrested. Hazaribag SP Aman Kumar said police received a tip-off that a group of traffickers was arriving in Chouparan for an opium deal. After verifying the information, police deployed teams at suspected locations. During surveillance, police spotted three men near a place of worship on GT Road with a blue car and an unregistered motorcycle. The team surrounded the suspects and apprehended two of them, while the third fled towards a nearby forest. Police said the fleeing suspect opened fire when personnel gave chase. The team retaliated in self-defence, hitting him on the left side of his abdomen. He was subsequently taken into custody. The injured accused was identified as [Ajay Kumar Singh](#), 23, a resident of Champi in Bihar's Gaya district. After preliminary treatment, he was referred to Rajendra Institute of Medical Sciences (Rims) in Ranchi. The other accused were identified as Akash Harsh Raj, alias Hrithik Kumar, 26, of Uta More in Chatra, and [Sonu Kumar](#), 26, of Kahudag in Gaya. Kolkata: The Railway Protection Force (RPF) seized 22.64 kg of suspected cannabis (ganja) from a passenger at Howrah railway station and detained him while he was proceeding towards Platform 8, Eastern Railway said on Sunday.

The passenger, identified as 22-year-old Rabiya, a native of Cooch Behar and currently residing in north-west Delhi, was intercepted near Platform 8, Pillar 2, after an RPF sniffer dog, Marco, indicated a sky-blue trolley bag he was carrying.

According to the RPF, the seizure was made during a checking operation conducted by the Crime Intelligence Branch (CIB), Howrah, in coordination with local RPF personnel, based on source information about the movement of narcotic substances through the station.

A search of the trolley bag in the presence of senior officials and independent witnesses led to the recovery of 11 tape-wrapped packets containing the suspected contraband, weighing 22.64 kg in total. A mobile phone and other personal belongings were also seized.

तलाशी के क्रम में दोनों के पास से कुल 13.12 ग्राम ब्राउन शुगर बरामद किया गया। पूछताछ में जानकारी मिली कि दोनों ओडिशा से ब्राउन शुगर लाकर शहर में बेचते थे। पुलिस को कुछ अन्य जानकारियां भी मिली हैं जिसके आधार पर छापेमारी की जा रही है।

घाटशिला थानाक्षेत्र में ब्राउन शुगर की तस्करी के खिलाफ पुलिस ने कार्रवाई करते हुए 2 युवकों को गिरफ्तार किया है। पुलिस ने इनके पास से 13.12 ग्राम ब्राउन शुगर, एक बाइक और 2 मोबाइल फोन बरामद किया है। दोनों आरोपी मुसाबनी से ब्राउन शुगर की खेप लेकर घाटशिला में बिक्री के लिए पहुंचे थे। गिरफ्तार आरोपियों की पहचान मुसाबनी 3 नंबर हरिजन बस्ती निवासी 19 वर्षीय जय महानंद और मुसाबनी निवासी 19 वर्षीय आकर्षित कुमार के रूप में हुई है। पुलिस ने दोनों को न्यायिक हिरासत में भेज दिया है।

**SSP को मिली गुप्त सूचना पर हुई कार्रवाई** ग्रामीण एसपी शुभम खंडेलवाल ने रविवार को जमशेदपुर में प्रेस कॉन्फ्रेंस कर बताया कि 29 अगस्त को पुलिस को सूचना मिली थी कि मुसाबनी से 2 युवक ब्राउन शुगर लेकर घाटशिला पहुंचने वाले हैं। सूचना के आधार पर एसएसपी के निर्देश पर घाटशिला एसडीपीओ विकास कुमार लागुरी के नेतृत्व में छापामारी टीम गठित की गई। टीम ने अमायईनगर पुलिया के पास संदिग्ध गतिविधियों के आधार पर 2 युवकों को रोका। तलाशी लेने पर उनके पास से 13.12 ग्राम ब्राउन शुगर बरामद हुई। पुलिस ने मौके से काले रंग की स्प्लेंडर बाइक और दो मोबाइल फोन भी जब्त किया।

पुलिस अब बरामद ब्राउन शुगर के स्रोत और इसके पीछे सक्रिय सप्लाय नेटवर्क की पड़ताल कर रही है। यह भी पता लगाया जा रहा है कि इस कारोबार में आरोपियों के अलावा और कौन-कौन लोग शामिल हैं।

**हजारीबाग :** झारखंड के हजारीबाग जिले में पुलिस और हथियारबंद तस्करों के बीच हुई संक्षिप्त मुठभेड़ के बाद तीन तस्करों को गिरफ्तार कर लिया गया है। इस दौरान पुलिस की जवाबी कार्रवाई में एक आरोपी के पेट में गोली लग गई जिसे बेहतर इलाज के लिए रांची के रिम्स अस्पताल में भर्ती कराया गया है। एक वरिष्ठ पुलिस अधिकारी ने रविवार को यह जानकारी दी।

पुलिस ने बताया कि पकड़े गये लोगों में से दो बिहार के गयाजी जिले के रहने वाले हैं और पुलिस ने उनके पास से अफीम बरामद की है। उन्होंने बताया कि गुप्त सूचना के आधार पर पुलिस की एक टीम ने शनिवार की शाम चौपारण थाना क्षेत्र में हथिया बाबा मंदिर के पास छापा मारा जहां आरोपी अफीम बेचने के लिए एकत्र हुए थे।

अधिकारी के अनुसार पुलिस ने दो आरोपियों को पकड़ लिया जबकि तीसरे ने भागने की कोशिश की तो पुलिसकर्मियों ने उसका पीछा किया। इसके बाद उसने पुलिस पर गोली चला दी। चौपारण थाना प्रभारी पंकज कुमार ने बताया, पुलिस ने जवाबी कार्रवाई की जिसके परिणामस्वरूप मुठभेड़ हुई।

इस दौरान उसके पेट में गोली लग गयी। उसकी पहचान बिहार के गयाजी जिले के रहने वाले अजय कुमार सिंह के रूप में हुयी है। सिंह को बरही अनुमंडलीय अस्पताल ले जाया गया जहां से उसे रिम्स रांची भेज दिया गया। उन्होंने बताया कि गिरफ्तार किए गए अन्य दो आरोपियों की पहचान झारखंड के चतरा जिले के आकाश हर्ष राज उर्फ ऋतिक कुमार और बिहार के गयाजी निवासी सोनू कुमार के रूप में हुई है।

वहीं पुलिस ने आरोपियों के कब्जे से 10 किलोग्राम अफीम, एक देसी पिस्तौल, दो कारतूस, एक कारतूस का खोखा, एक कार, बिना नंबर प्लेट की एक मोटरसाइकिल और तीन मोबाइल फोन बरामद किए हैं। फिलहाल थाना प्रभारी ने बताया कि मामले की आगे की जांच की जा रही है।
