Seizure of 4.166 Kg Opium: NCB Jodhpur Busts Trafficking Module, Four Arrested

The Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB), Jodhpur Zonal Unit, has busted a major drug syndicate involved in Opium smuggling across Rajasthan.

On 16.08.2025, acting on specific intelligence, a team of NCB Jodhpur intercepted a motorcycle on Kankani Road, Jodhpur, and seized 4.166 kg of opium from the possession of two individuals, who were arrested on the spot. The contraband was sourced from Chittorgarh and was destined for Jodhpur for local distribution. The value of the seized drug is estimated at approximately ₹20.83 lakh.

In a follow-up operation, the receiver and supplier of the seized opium were also arrested. Further investigation in this case is underway.

This seizure exemplifies the NCB's commitment to dismantle the drug network in order to accomplish the vision of DRUG FREE INDIA.
