Drug Trafficker Sentenced To 12 Years Rigorous Imprisonment in Ahmedabad

Pursuant to the vision of Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi of a DRUG FREE INDIA (Nasha Mukht Bharat) and acting upon the directives of Hon'ble Union Home Minister Narcotics Control Bureau has achieved success in ensuring that drug offenders are brought to justice.

The City Civil and Sessions Court in Ahmedabad (Bhadra) has convicted Nasir Hussain Gulam Hussain for smuggling of 39.68 kg of Charas, and sentenced him to 12 years of rigorous imprisonment along with a fine of Rs. 6 lakh.

On 17.09.2003, the officers of the NCB had intercepted a major narcotic consignment near Kalupur Railway Station, Ahmedabad leading to recovery of 29.530 kilograms of Charas. A follow-up operation a day later led to seizure of additional 10.150 kilograms of Charas.

In this matter 09 individuals were arrested. One accused Nasir Hussain Gulam Hussain absconded in 2004. Trail against the 08 accused was completed in 2008 and all of them were convicted under Sections 8(c), 22(b)(ii)(C), and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

The remaining absconding accused Nasir Hussain Gulam Hussain was apprehended 17 year latter in 2022. He was tried separately by City Civil and Sessions Court, Ahmedabad (Bhadra). This court on 10.03.2025 convicted accused Nasir Hussain Gulam Hussain, under Sections 8(c), 22(b)(ii)(C), and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, and sentenced him 12 years of rigorous imprisonment (RI) along with a fine of Rs. 6,00,000 (Rupees Six Lakhs only). The conviction exemplifies the NCB's relentless efforts in dismantling drug networks.
