In a significant achievement, the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB), Guwahati Zonal Unit, has successfully secured the conviction of an accused involved in inter-state drug trafficking. The case pertains to the seizure of a commercial quantity of Ganja from an individual engaged in smuggling activities across state borders.

2. On 20.10.2020, officers of the NCB Guwahati Zonal Unit intercepted a truck and seized 1,350 kilograms(appx.) of Ganja concealed within the tank of the vehicle and arrested one accused. The investigation established that the accused was involved in the inter-state trafficking of Ganja, which was being transported from Tripura to Guwahati, Assam.

3. Upon completion of the investigation and collection of evidence, a complaint was filed before the Hon'ble Court. On 28.05.2025, the Hon'ble Additional District and Sessions Court, Kamrup (Metro), Assam, convicted the accused and awarded a sentence of 10 years of Rigorous Imprisonment (RI), along with a fine of ₹1 lakh under the provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985.

4. The conviction exemplifies the NCB's commitment to accomplish the vision of DRUG FREE INDIA.
