

Notification

New Delhi, the ___April, 2019.

G.S.R._— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau (Director General) Recruitment Rules 2006, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Director General in the Narcotics Control Bureau under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

1 Short title and commencement. — (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Director General, Group 'A', Gazetted Post Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix.—The number of the said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.— The method of recruitment, age- limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Disqualification. — No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living;
or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.— Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultations with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. — Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation in age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the ex-servicemen and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note.— (Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization or Department of the Central Government shall not exceed five years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 58 years, as on the closing date of the receipt of applications).
