NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, Dated, the 2023.

- **1 Short title and commencement.** (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Additional Director Group 'A' post Recruitment Rules, 2022.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix.—The number of the said post(s), their classification and Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- **3.Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.** Method of recruitment, age-limit, other qualifications etc. and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
 - 4. Disqualification. No person,—
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax.— Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation in agelimit, and other concessions required to be provided for Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation:-

Officers of the Central Government or the State Government or Union Territories Administration;

- (a) (i) holding analogous post in Level-13 on regular basis; or
 - (ii) with five year's regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in level 12 of the pay matrix Rs. 78800- 209200 or equivalent, in the parent cadre or department; and
- (b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience, namely:-
 - (i) Bachelor's degree from recognized university
 - (ii) 10 years' experience in the enforcement of regulatory laws and collection of intelligence relating thereto.

Desirable: -Four year's experience in the investigation of criminal offences including economic offences.

Note 1: The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on promotion.

Note 2: Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed five years.

Note 3: The age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation shall be not exceeding fifty six years on the closing date of receipt of applications.
