G.S.R.______ In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau (Deputy Director/ Zonal Director), Recruitment Rules, 2010, except as respect thins done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment of the post of Deputy Director/Zonal Director in the Narcotics Control Bureau under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

- **1 Short title and commencement.** (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau (Deputy Director/ Zonal Director) Recruitment Rules, 2020.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix.—The number of posts, its classification and Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.— Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
 - 4. Disqualification. No person,—
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax.— Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation in age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Promotion:

Assistant Director with five years of regular service in level-11 (Rs. 67700-208700) of pay matrix and successfully undergone 03 weeks mandatory training, for which training program to be prepared and imparted by the NCB or at another institute approved by NCB.

Note 1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility considered being service are promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation:-

Officers of the Central Government or the State Government or Union Territories Administration;

- (a) (i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
 - (ii) with five year's regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in level 11 of the pay matrix Rs. 67700-208700 or equivalent, in the parent cadre or department; and
- (b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience, namely:-
 - (i) Bachelor's degree from a recognized University;
 - (ii) Eight years' experience in the enforcement of regulatory laws and collection of intelligence relating thereto.

Desirable: - (i) Four year's experience in the investigation of criminal offences including economic offences.

(ii) Working knowledge in computer

Group 'A' Departmental Promotion Committee (for considering promotion) consisting of:

- (1) Chairperson or Member Union Public Service Commission Chairman
- (2) Director General,
 Narcotics Control Bureau
 Member
- (3) Joint Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs Member

Consultation with Union Public Service Commission necessary while appointing an officer on deputation.

Note 1: The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for appointment consideration for deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on promotion. Note 2: Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed four years. Note 3: The age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation shall be not

exceeding fifty six years on the closing

date of receipt of applications.
